Our Parents are a vital part of our school community and their actions not only indicate the type of school we have but also dictate what type of school we will be.

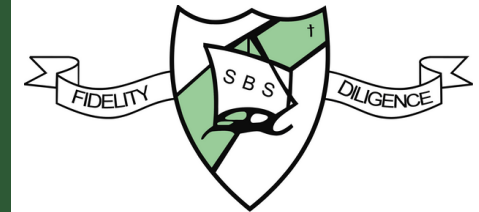
Our Parents, Teachers & Friends enable visions to be realized by not only fundraising for money to support school projects but also in the building of positive relationships by involving everyone in the school.

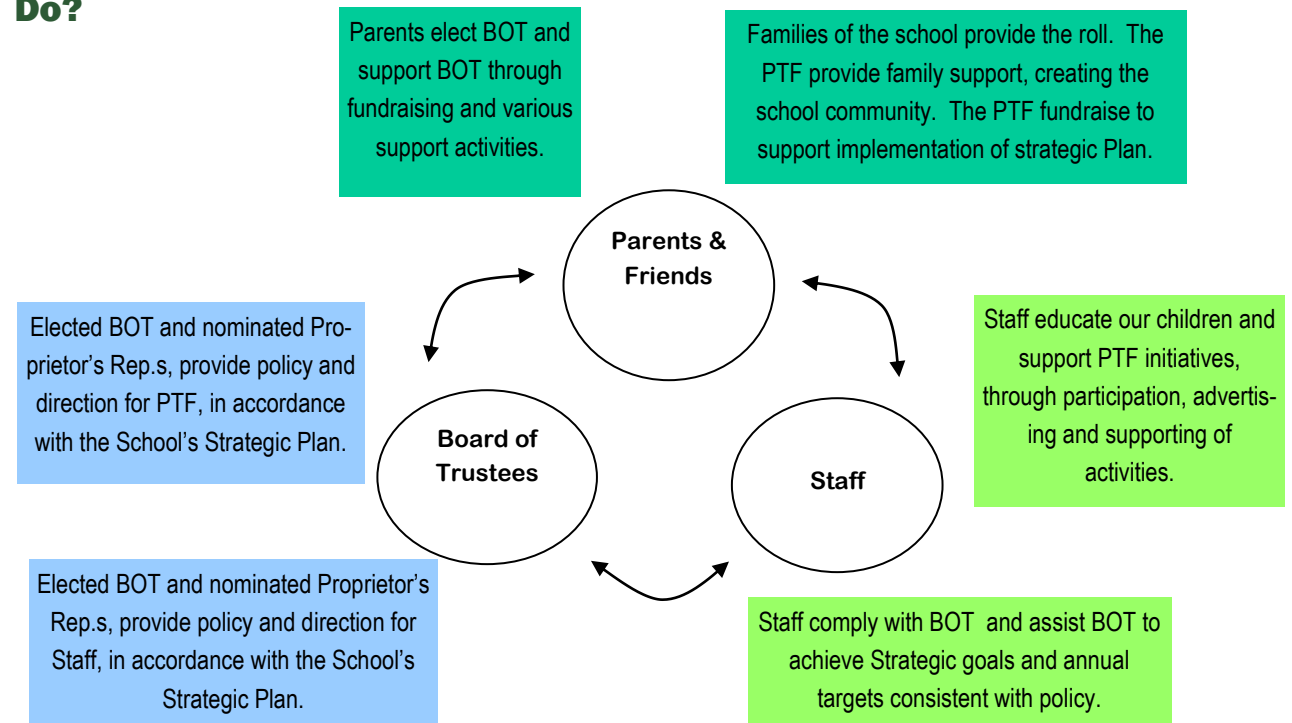
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Who are the Parents, Teachers & Friends?
