Review Findings Summary:

The contributions to the Pastoral Care review were a satisfying Parents (56), Teachers (10), and students (55). Summarised findings are detailed on the attached page.

Overall the responses highlighted a number of positive pastoral activities that are evident at St Brendan's. There were also a number of suggestions that have been themed and prioritised for inclusion in the annual plan. Please see [Pastoral Care Review Findings](#).

We continue to be in a state of change within the school and this has been unsettling. As such this anxiety has been reflected to an extent in the results.

Of significance however was the overwhelming positivity around pastoral care reflected in the student surveys. These results also compared favourably across all categories against New Zealand data.
